SUBJECT: 1990-91 Street Seal Coat Program (PN:RC16/RC66) - Contract
Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is a continuation of the program to apply a seal coat to various streets in the City to forestall deterioration of the existing pavement which would necessitate reconstruction of the street surfaces. This project will apply a seal coat to 202 different locations within the City.

On July 3, 1990, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on July 24, 1990. The bids received were:

California Pavement Maintenance Co., Inc.	\$299,031.82
Valley Slurry Seal Co.	346,127.90

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$308,000. The estimated project completion date is October 20, 1990.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$390,000. The current budget is \$995,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Gas Tax funds (202). The funds available for this project amount to \$642,000, as of July 24, 1990.

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code governing award of contracts.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. There were four (4) planholders for this project, none of whom are certified MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of California Pavement Maintenance Co., Inc. in the amount of \$299,031.82, and award the contract.


