

ORDINANCE NO. 1244, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1230, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 29, 1946, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1066, 1067, 1074, 1084, 1090, 1094, 1098, 1105, 1107, 1112, 1119, 1124, 1128, 1136, 1142, 1145, 1157, 1163, 1164, 1170, 1175, 1176, 1182, 1184, 1188, 1197, 1190, 1203, 1206, 1216, 1219 AND 1221, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT DECEMBER 1, 1946," BY AMENDING SUBDIVISION "CRAFTS AND LABOR - SUPERVISORY" AND SUBDIVISION "CRAFTS AND LABOR," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 1230, Fourth Series, passed November 29, 1946, is hereby amended by amending Subdivision "CRAFTS AND LABOR - SUPERVISORY" and Subdivision "CRAFTS AND LABOR:"

1	Operator, Chief Radio	1.93 3/4	per hour

CRAFTS AND LABOR

1	Blacksmith-Welder	\$1.60	per hour
1	Mechanic, Auto	1.60	per hour
1	Operator, Radio	1.50	per hour
1	Repairman, Body and Fender	1.70	per hour

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that it is necessary that the salary adjustment provided for herein become effective immediately.
