NOTICE OF DECISION

AND

FINDINGS OF FACT

At its regular meeting of December 14, 1982, the City Council heard and considered evidence in the above entitled matter. Based on the oral and documentary evidence at such hearing, the Council denied the appeal and upheld the Planning Commission's action to deny the project. The Council's action was based on the following findings:

- 1. The proposed rezoning to M-l is not based on sound land use principles in that the site is adjacent to residential on three sides.
- 2. The granting of a rezoning to M-1 would intrude into a residential area.
- 3. The project is contrary to the 1974 General Plan which discourages incompatible uses to be located in existing residential neighborhoods.
